STAND HOLDER REGULATIONS

1. Applications which are not accompanied by the appropriate fee will not be accepted.
2. BASEC reserve the right to refuse any application without giving any explanation and to determine the area and position of sites.
3. Imitation fire arms are prohibited from sale at this event.
4. Exhibitors shall not sub-let space.
5. Stands must be open and continuously manned during the hours the fair is open to the public.
6. A Risk Assessment form will be sent to you along with the final details, this should be completed and reviewed when the stand is set up. Any safety equipment required should be provided by the stand holder. Completed forms should be returned to the Secretary's caravan.
7. All stands should be in place on the events field and ready for the public no later than 10am. Stands should remain on the events field until 4pm unless prior permission has been obtained from a Committee Member.
8. Judging of stands will take place on Sunday morning.
9. Stand Holders are responsible for the security of their stands. The Club cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage however caused.
10. Stand holders are responsible for ensuring that the health and safety of themselves, club officials and members of the public is at no time compromised by their acts or omissions.
11. Stand holders are responsible for the safe erection of their stand and goods on display by 10am each day and dismantling. Goods displayed must be in accordance with the description on the application form. Stand holders are required to follow any instructions given to them by club officials. The use of loud speaking appliances is prohibited without the written permission of the club.
12. BASEC reserve the right to remove any stand holder making undue noise or behaving in a manner calculated to annoy other stand holders, exhibitors or the public.
13. Stand holders are responsible for leaving their pitch in a tidy condition, litter should be disposed of in the bins provided or removed from the site. Any infringement of this condition may attract a fine.
14. All stand holders shall agree to indemnify and hold harmless the organisers of the Castle Fraser Steam & Vintage Fair from any claim for loss, damage or injury whatsoever caused by their trade stand/exhibit, or the crew thereof, whilst taking part in, driving at, or travelling to or from the event and will produce on demand evidence of third party insurance cover.
15. The club reserves the right to impose a surcharge of 50% on trade stand holders who do not apply and pay the appropriate fee 48 hours in advance of the event.
16. In the event of the Fair being terminated early due to inclement weather or for any other reason, there shall be no refund of the fee.
17. In any question regarding the meaning, interpretation or intent of these regulations, the decision of the committee is final.
18. **NOTE: In the interests of safety - Vehicles to be parked up prior to public entry to the Fair at 10am. Vehicle movements are prohibited during the hours the Fair is open to the public. Vehicle movements may only recommence when the Fair closes after 4.30pm on Saturday and 4pm on Sunday**

The Committee of the Bon Accord Steam Engine Club reserves the right to take action against any exhibitor or participant found to be in breach of these rules and regulations.

Data Protection

The committee of the Bon Accord Steam Engine Club Limited ("BASEC" or the "Club") takes your privacy seriously. BASEC is committed to complying with data protection rules and ensuring data security. BASEC collects data from those who exhibit at our events.

Stand Holders

BASEC collects your data via our event entry forms (the data we collect usually includes your name, trading name, postal address and e-mail address if provided). We collect your data to help us run our events. We use your data so that we can send you information about forthcoming and future events run by BASEC. BASEC relies on the "legitimate interests" lawful basis for processing data under data protection rules. BASEC has a legitimate interest in processing your data so that we can continue to run our events for the benefit of exhibitors, club members, and the public at large.

What we do with your data/your rights

We do not share your data with any third parties. We maintain separate databases for each of our events. When you submit an entry form your data will be stored on the relevant event database for a period of seven years. Our databases are used solely for the purpose of running our events, administering the club and communicating with you. If you do not want us to hold your data on our databases please e-mail secretary@bonaccordsteamclub.co.uk or contact our secretary in writing (details above) and we will remove your details from our systems (this will mean that you will not be contacted by BASEC in future).
